Baby teeth are important!

- Baby teeth help your child to chew, speak, and smile
- Cavities on baby teeth can be painful
- Cavities on baby teeth can transfer to permanent teeth

Give your child a great start to a lifetime of healthy teeth by making that first appointment!

At the first check-up, the dentist will:

- Check your child for cavities or problems
- Show you how to clean your baby's teeth
- Discuss how sharing germs can cause cavities
- Discuss how your choices about sugar affect cavities
- Talk about nursing and other infant issues

Cavities on baby teeth can grow quickly!


